ASPC EUROPEAN FORUM

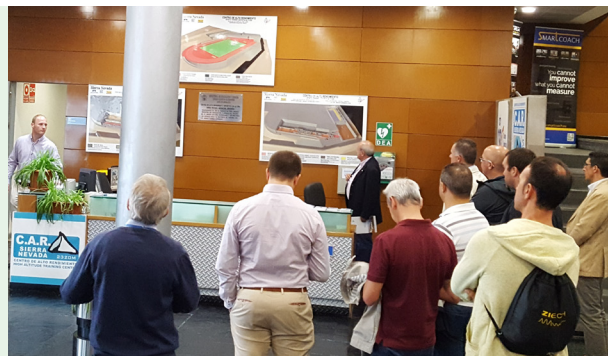
Over 40 sport performance professionals attended the ASPC European Forum on October 4-7 at the CAR Sierra Nevada.
