



ASPC Membership Report

After an overview of the membership evolution of the last 2 years we have identified an stabilization of the numbers reached until 2011 with a variability of the potential and the paid ones.

America, Asia and Oceania have not experienced changes, Europe an slow % reduction and Africa a big growth compared to the previous years.

In 2012 we had 75 centres on the list which have grown up to 78 this year. However only 55 members have completed the payment of the corresponding fees, one less than in 2012.

Below is shown the evolution of membership per continent:

The evolution is explained as follows:

Africa: Three new members have applied this year: Sports Science Durban – Soth Africa, Kipkeino High Performance Training Centre – Kenya, College of Medecine Sports Complex – Malawi and Centre National des Sports Moulay Rachid – Morocco. Morocco has been approached by Hassan Baraka who was collaborating with INSEP for several months. They haven't paid yet the joining fee. On the other hand Mpumalanga Academy of Sport is no longer member because they have been dissolved.

America: Centro Olímpico de Alto Rendimiento (ECU) in Ecuador had always paid until 2011, however they have missed paying the last two years.

Asia: Takashi has recommended Institut Sukan Negara (National Sports Institute of Malyasia) as a new member. Still waiting for the application form.

Europe: A new member has applied: Jasmor Centro Deportivo Nacional – Portugal. However HPSTC University of Bath have decided to discontinue

their membership. Some other members have applied to be members in the last two years and been accepted by the BoD but they haven't paid the corresponding fees:

CTO Amsterdam, accepted in Sant Cugat 2012 – Haven't paid fees
Irish Institute of Sport –Ireland, BoD Paris 2011 – Haven't paid fees

Several mails have been sent from the Secretariat reminding the lack of payment.
